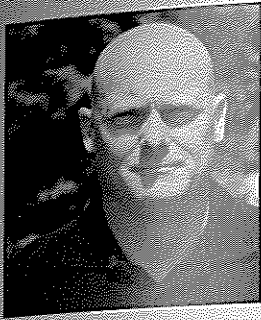

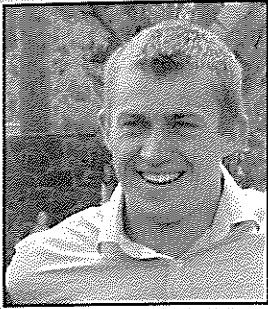

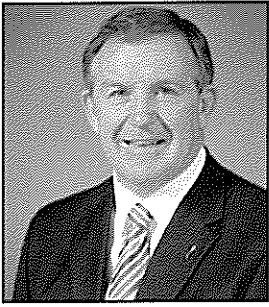
We would also like to thank the AWWF, our Australian Governing body in Skiing, for their support in our quest to promote barefoot water skiing here.

Events Description



Tricks Each skier is permitted two passes through the course, one up, and one back, each pass being fifteen seconds in duration. During This time skiers attempt to complete, to a standard, as many tricks as possible .Each trick is reward a set amount of points for successful completion and its degree of difficulty. Some of the tricks attempted at a national level are multiple surface turns, toe holds, line steps, tumble turns and so on. The skier is given extra points for starting by jumping from the dock or for standing up on one foot and various different methods of starting.



Wake Slalom Once again the skier is allowed two fifteen second passes through the course. In this time the skier attempts as many crosses of the wake as he or she can complete. There are different levels of scoring and more points are given for crossing the wake on one foot rather than two and more points again for crossing backwards on one foot rather than forwards.



Jump This is probably the most spectacular event from a spectator point of view as it is accomplished right in front of the crowd. The competitor may choose a speed no greater than Seventy – two kilometers per hour for their pass over the jump in the barefoot position and then land and ski away from the jump to register a score. They are given three attempts to do this and the aim is to achieve the longest distance from the jump to the landing.
