### **HISTORY OF BAREFOOT WATER SKIING**

The sport of barefoot water sking began in America in the 1950's. Dick Pope Jnr was the first person to be officially recorded as achieving this technique, although there is some doubt as to whether he was actually the first person ever to water ski without skis on his bare feet. The Australians were the first to really take it seriously and make it a competitive sport.

The first World Championships were held in Canberra, Australia in 1978 and the Australians won it hands down, with New Zealand second and the USA a close third. Ten teams took part. The championships have been held biannually ever since, Australia reigning supreme up until 1986 when the championships were held for the first time in Europe, at Kelheim, Germany. Here too for the first time, the Americans took the team title away from the Australians and have maintained their dominance to this day. Since then the Junior and Senior World Championships have been developed and we are presently taking part in the sixth Junior and forth Senior event.

Barefoot water skiing has been well established for many years now and is internationally recognized and acknowledged by the International Olympic Committee. Barefoot waterskiing is now an established competitive sport in the World Games, which are held every four years. This is a great event for barefooting and gives us a stage like other sports in the world.


