
All skiers should remain on site in case of changes to the schedule.


* The first round is a combined elimination round. This means that all skiers, regardless of whether they are seniors, juniors or opens, will be split into gender divisions (male & female) and ski once in their seeded order. This may result in a low seeded senior skiing in the same event as a low seeded junior, or a high seeded opens skier skiing in the same event as an equally high seeded junior. This round will determine which skiers qualify for the second round. This is in accordance with rule 1908 of the 2016 Barefoot Water Ski Technical Rules.






