Orlando International Airport is the one of the most popular airports in Central Florida with more than 50 million passengers in 2019. It is often ranked as one of the best large airports in the USA!





SECTION 3

HEALTH CERTIFICATE

USA DROPPED TRAVEL BAN FOR VACCINATED INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS IN 2022.

The United States announced a new international air travel system, opening travel for all vaccinated foreign nationals in early 2022, including those currently impacted by the U.S. travel ban.

Travelers will not need to show proof of full vaccination prior to boarding U.S.-bound planes. A COVID-19 test is also not required or proof of negative results. Enhanced contact tracing and masking are not required.



Visas

Passports must be valid for six months beyond the date the traveler will exit the United States.

Generally, a citizen of a foreign country who wishes to enter the United States must first obtain a visa. Visitor visas are nonimmigrant visas for persons who want to enter the United States temporarily for tourism (visa category B-2)

The Visa Waiver Program (VWP) enables most citizens or nationals of participating countries* to travel to the United States for tourism or business for stays of 90 days or less without obtaining a visa. In order to travel without a visa on the VWP, you must have authorization through the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to boarding a U.S. bound air or sea carrier.

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan*, United Kingdom**

Citizens of Canada do not require visas to enter the United States.

Citizens of Mexico will need a Border Crossing Card (BCC) which is both a BCC and a B1/B2 visitor's visa.

Chinese citizens with 10-year B1, B2 or B1/B2 visas in Peoples' Republic of China passports will be required to update their biographical and other information from their visa application via a website every two years, or upon getting a new passport or B1, B2, or B1/B2 visa, whichever occurs first. This mechanism is called EVUS - Electronic Visa Update System.

In 2022, Central Florida celebrated the invention of the sport and it was a focal point of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports and the Foundation's celebration of the 100 years of the invention of water skiing. We look forward to having skiers from around the world come back to their roots to join us in the Water Ski Capital of the World!



WATER SKI CAPITAL

Central Florida is known as the *Water Ski Capital of the World*. Nowhere else in the sport has had more records broken or inspired the continued evolution of the sport. Water skiing may have been invented in 1922 by Ralph Samuelson on Lake Pepin in Minnesota but Dick Pope, Sr.'s Cypress Gardens transformed it into a global sport and entertainment phenomenon. No other destination on the planet has the history, inventions, world firsts, world records and visibility than Florida's first theme park, Cypress Gardens.


BALMORAL RESORT

Side Set Up

Championship Lake is a freshwater lake located in Lake Myrtle Sports Park. The lake is 2300ft long (640m), 300ft wide (91m) with the lake depth 8-12 ft (2-3.5m) in the middle. It is a private lake that stretches north to south with one point of entry at a private boat ramp.

Following the agreement made by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF Licence Fee. A skier without a valid IWWF Licence will not be permitted to compete in the event.

DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. Information about the IWWF Anti-Doping program, the current IWWF AD Rules and links to the list of banned substances can be accessed on the IWWF Website.
