## **Agenda Items and Discussions**

# 1. Review of 2024 World Championships:

- Scoring and Streaming: The scoring system was effective but required significant pre-event preparation. The live streaming needs simplification for future events.
- Event Setup: The LOC setup was praised for its excellence. However, a site map for positioning and layout was suggested to improve pre-event coordination at future events.
- Officials' Timing: It was suggested that officials arrive a day earlier to reduce last-minute rushes.

# 2. Scoring and IT Challenges:

- Scoring System: Issues with the speed of starting lists and results dissemination were noted. There is a need for dedicated IT personnel to handle scoring and data entry.
- Provisional Scores: Discussion on implementing live scoring from boats to improve real-time results sharing.

#### 3. Tournament Format and Structure

- Two-Lake System: While logistically challenging, using two lakes was considered effective for the tournament's flow.
- Future Format Changes: Consideration of separating junior and under-23 competitions from open divisions to streamline events and reduce costs.

# 4. Regional Championships Integration:

 Proposal to include regional championships within world tournaments by awarding medals based on regional performance without altering the main event structure.

## 5. Judging Innovations:

 Slalom Judging Proposal: A new subjective scoring system was proposed to improve accuracy and reduce reliance on video reviews. This would involve a trial at select clubs or video trials before further broader consideration or implementation.

#### 6. Future Events and Locations:

• Discussion on potential locations for the 2026 World Championships, emphasising the need for new venues to maintain skier interest.

# 7. Council Leadership Transition:

• John Cornish was proposed as the new secretary, with a transition plan in place until the conclusion of the Masters Championship in Chartres.

#### **Decisions Made**

- Adopt New Scoring Trials: Agreed to trial a new slalom judging system.
- Regional Championships Proposal: To be further developed with council input.
- Leadership Transition Plan: Approved transition plan for council secretary role to Chairman of the World Barefoot Council Effective 14<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

## **Action Items**

- Develop detailed site map templates for future events.
- Recruit additional IT support for scoring tasks.
- Prepare guidelines and video presentations for the proposed slalom judging system trial.
- Finalise regional championship integration details for further discussion at WBC meeting.

## **Closing Remarks**

The meeting concluded with discussions on improving marketing strategies and sponsorship acquisition for future events, emphasising the importance of digital presence and athlete engagement.
