
Our Location AUBURNDALE, FLORIDA

ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (MCO)

48 miles or 77km

Orlando International Airport is the one of the most popular airports in Central Florida with more than 50 million passengers in 2019. It is often ranked as one of the best large airports in the USA!

It's a great choice for both International and domestic flights. There is a large list of airlines serving the airport: Aer Lingus for flights into Ireland; Alaskan, American, AeroMexico, British Airways, Copa for South America; Swiss, Delta, Emirates for the Middle East; Icelandair for Iceland, Hawaiian Airlines, Frontier, LATAM for South America; Norwegian, United, Spirit and Southwest, Virgin Atlantic to Europe, and Jet Blue.

If you happen to have a Priority Pass membership from one of your credit cards, there are two The Club lounges at MCO one for airside 1 for gates 1-29 and one airside 4 gates 70-99!

Visas

Passports must be valid for six months beyond the date the traveler will exit the United States.

Generally, a citizen of a foreign country who wishes to enter the United States must first obtain a visa. Visitor visas are nonimmigrant visas for persons who want to enter the United States temporarily for tourism (visa category B-2)

The Visa Waiver Program (VWP) enables most citizens or nationals of participating countries* to travel to the United States for tourism or business for stays of 90 days or less without obtaining a visa. In order to travel without a visa on the VWP, you must have authorization through the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to boarding a U.S. bound air or sea carrier.

Citizens of Canada do not require visas to enter the United States.

Citizens of Mexico will need a Border Crossing Card (BCC) which is both a BCC and a B1/B2 visitor's visa.

Chinese citizens with 10-year B1, B2 or B1/B2 visas in Peoples' Republic of China passports will be required to update their biographical and other information from their visa application via a website every two years, or upon getting a new passport or B1, B2, or B1/B2 visa, whichever occurs first. This mechanism is called EVUS - Electronic Visa Update

CAR RENTALS

ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Orlando is the largest rental car market in the world, with most of the major car rental companies located on-airport, without the need for a shuttle bus to pick up your rental car. The on-airport rental car companies are located on the A-Side and B-Side of the Terminal on the Ground Transportation Level (Level 1).

Enterprise Holdings is the parent company of car rental agencies Enterprise Rent-A-Car, National Car Rental and Alamo Rent a Car. Enterprise is located on level 1 in both the A and B terminals. All Enterprise

vehicles are located on the first floor of the parking garage across the street from the terminal and are within walking distance. The car rental location is on-site at Orlando International Airport (MCO).



GAS (PETROL) STATIONS



The Shell station at the South Travel Plaza offers competitively priced gas. It is located on the south entrance/exit road at the junction of Jeff Fuqua Blvd. and South Park Place, adjacent to the South APM Station.



ROAD TOLLS

Toll roads from the Orlando airport require a transponder (like SunPass or E-ZPass) or by toll-by-plate. (cameras photograph your license plate and send a bill afterward).

Pay-by-plate billing: If you don't have an electronic transponder, the system will bill the registered vehicle owner by mail for the tolls (often at a higher rate than with a transponder).

CHECK IN

Competitors, officials and dignitaries are required to check in and sign waivers to receive their credentials and event bags.

TEAM SKIERS

Not later than 4 weeks before the scheduled start of the Championship, each Federation intending to enter a team shall certify to the Chairman of the WBC, the Chairman of the Confederation Barefoot Council the Chief Judge and the LOC, the names of the skiers (Maximum of six for Open, four for Junior, and four for Senior) that will be skiing team members, and the events each will enter on the Definitive Entry Form. The names of up to two reserves for each team shall also be submitted on the same form.

FINAL LIST

Not later than 72 hours before the start of competition a Final Team List must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the WBC and the Chief Judge. This list, which shall be comprised solely of skiers named on the Definitive Entry Form, shall clearly indicate which are Team Skiers and which are Reserve Skiers as well as their relevant divisions. Failure to do so will disqualify the team from the team event.

INDEPENDENT SKIERS

Not later than 4 weeks before the scheduled start of the tournament, each Federation shall submit the names of any of its qualified independent skiers it wishes to enter, and the event or events they will enter on the Definitive Entry Form.

LATE FEE

Any Federation not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays to the WBC a fine of \$20 (USD) per skier per day after the four-week deadline, for each skier not officially entered.

EVENTS



Team members and Independent Individual athletes will have Free admission to **Social Events** and ceremonies.

(Competitors will be required to pay for their own drinks.)



Event Admission to the World Barefoot event is Free of charge to participants and spectators. Parking designated locations will be listed on the event website.



Team members and individual event competitors will have Free admission to the final night **Awards Banquet**. We will have more information in Bulletin 2 in regards to ticket costs for general admission.





Towboats used for the event and site familiarization will be Sanger towboats.



All athletes are required to be active in the IWWF EMS system. Please log in and update your profile so the event announcer has information available for the tournament. Contact your respective Federations if you are not an active/confirmed EMS user.

IWWF LICENCE

Following the agreement made by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF Licence Fee. A skier without a valid IWWF Licence will not be permitted to compete in the event.

DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. Information about the IWWF Anti-Doping program, the current IWWF AD Rules and links to the list of banned substances can be accessed on the IWWF Website.

SAFE SPORT

The IWWF takes safeguarding extremely seriously and is committed to ensuring that everyone who participates in the championships, whether athletes, officials or volunteers are able to operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. It is a condition of participation that all attendees familiarise themselves and comply with the IWWF Safeguarding Regulations on the IWWF Website.

Each team must bring an additional flag of their country. (Size approximately 100x150cm) National Anthems will be provided by Visit Central Florida.
