Host Organization

The Tournament Local Organizing Committee is comprised mainly of members of the Austin, Texas Barefoot Club. With the assistance of members of the American Barefoot Club elsewhere in the USA. Volunteers from Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and Europe are also supporting this tournament.

Texas has an active and diverse barefooting community, a substantial number of whom are active barefooters well into their senior years. This is also true of neighboring states. The Austin Texas Barefoot Club is also very active, regularly holding barefoot tournaments each year, including hosting the US National Barefoot Tournament in 2021 and 2022. Many Texas and Southwest skiers are quite enthusiastic about holding the IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships event in Texas, and have pledged their time, talent and treasure to make the event highly successful.

The Site

The site is located at Utopia Ski Ranch 8263 FM 621, Martindale Texas near San Marcos, between Austin and San Antonio, Texas. The site is ideally located approximately 10 miles off Interstate 35 as it runs through San Marcos.


San Marcos is a vibrant community along Interstate 35 about halfway between Austin and San Antonio Airports. There are several dedicated ski lakes in the area; the community has a history of supporting water ski tournaments, albeit not barefoot tournaments. USA WATER SKI & WAKE SPORTS (USA-WSWS) Safe Sport Policy

As a USA Water Ski & Wake Sports (USA-WSWS) sanctioned competition held in the U.S., all event participants must acknowledge that they have read and will follow the <u>Safe Sport Handbook</u>, adhere to the <u>MAAPP (Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention</u> <u>Polices)</u> protocol found in the USA-WSWS Safe Sport Handbook, and report any suspected or alleged MAAPP violations. No event participant, under any circumstance, should be currently listed on the USA- WSWS <u>Suspended Members</u> <u>List</u>. All participating IWWF-affiliated National Federations must assist the local organizing committee (LOC) in being compliant with the <u>Safe Sport Sanctioned Event</u> <u>Expectations</u>.

USA WATER SKI & WAKE SPORTS INSURANCE

All athletes are required to sign up as members of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports before they are permitted to compete in the 2022 IWWF World Masters Barefoot Water Ski Championships. Membership is required for insurance coverage during the event. For non-U.S. skiers, a guest membership will be required. There will be NO cost for the membership. A link to sign up for the membership will be provided in a further bulletin and Federations should ensure their athletes are signed up before official familiarization begins.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

The IWWF By-Law 16.1 states:

It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors for a World Titled Event to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and medical expenses.

ATHLETE INFORMATION FOR COMMENTATORS

Please request your athletes to log into IWWF's EMS to fill in / update their profiles (accomplishments, sponsors, social media handles, other interesting information in the "optional fields," etc.) so the event commentator has information available to communicate to spectators present at the event venue and online via live stream. They should also upload photos for media use. Athletes should contact their respective Federations if they are not active / confirmed EMS users. Please see the website under "register" for a suggested form bio.

IWWF LICENSE

Following agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF Licence fee for 2022 where competitors in Ranking List and Record Capability competitions in each Sports Division of the IWWF would be required to hold the IWWF Licence. Based on the above decision, a skier without a valid IWWF license will not be permitted to compete in IWWF World Masters Barefoot Championships. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their athletes hold a valid IWWF License.

Official Towboats

We will have fully equipped Sanger Barefooter towboats with fly-high attachment points available for the tournament.

Official Towrope and Handles

Masterline will provide all ropes and handles for the tournament.
