



Welcome to the 2012 Barefoot Worlds in Waco Texas! It is with great pleasure that I welcome each and every competitor to the 2012 Barefoot World Championships. The Barefoot Ski Ranch is a phenomenal venue for this event comprising of over 700 acres of property, wildlife that will amaze you, 2 fabulous barefoot lakes and a cable park. All of these within a short drive of downtown Waco, Texas.

This is the 18th Open Barefoot Worlds, 10th Junior Barefoot Worlds and the 8th Senior Barefoot Worlds. Many of the competitors in these events have trained for years to accomplish their goal of winning the Team Gold Medal and rising to the potential individual Gold in the final round. I hope that the training you have done over the years will provide the rewards you deserve. The Officials panel for this event is as strong as the skiers going for the gold.




