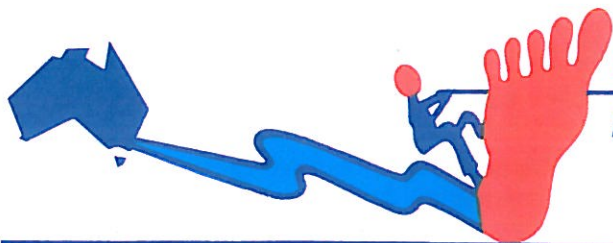

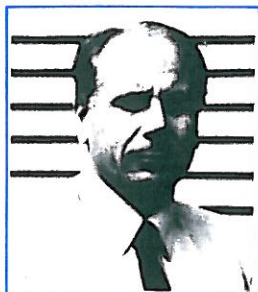

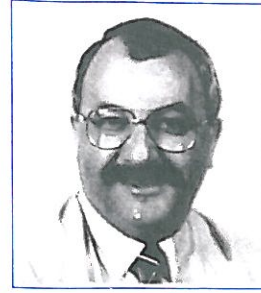


# AUSTRALIAN WATER SKI ASSOCIATION PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

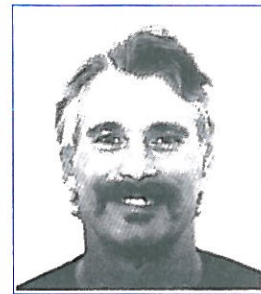
# A.B.W.S.C. PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

May I take this opportunity of extending a very warm welcome to our competitors both from overseas and all over Australia to the 6th World Barefoot Championship.

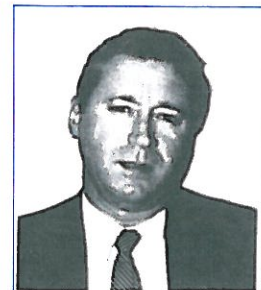

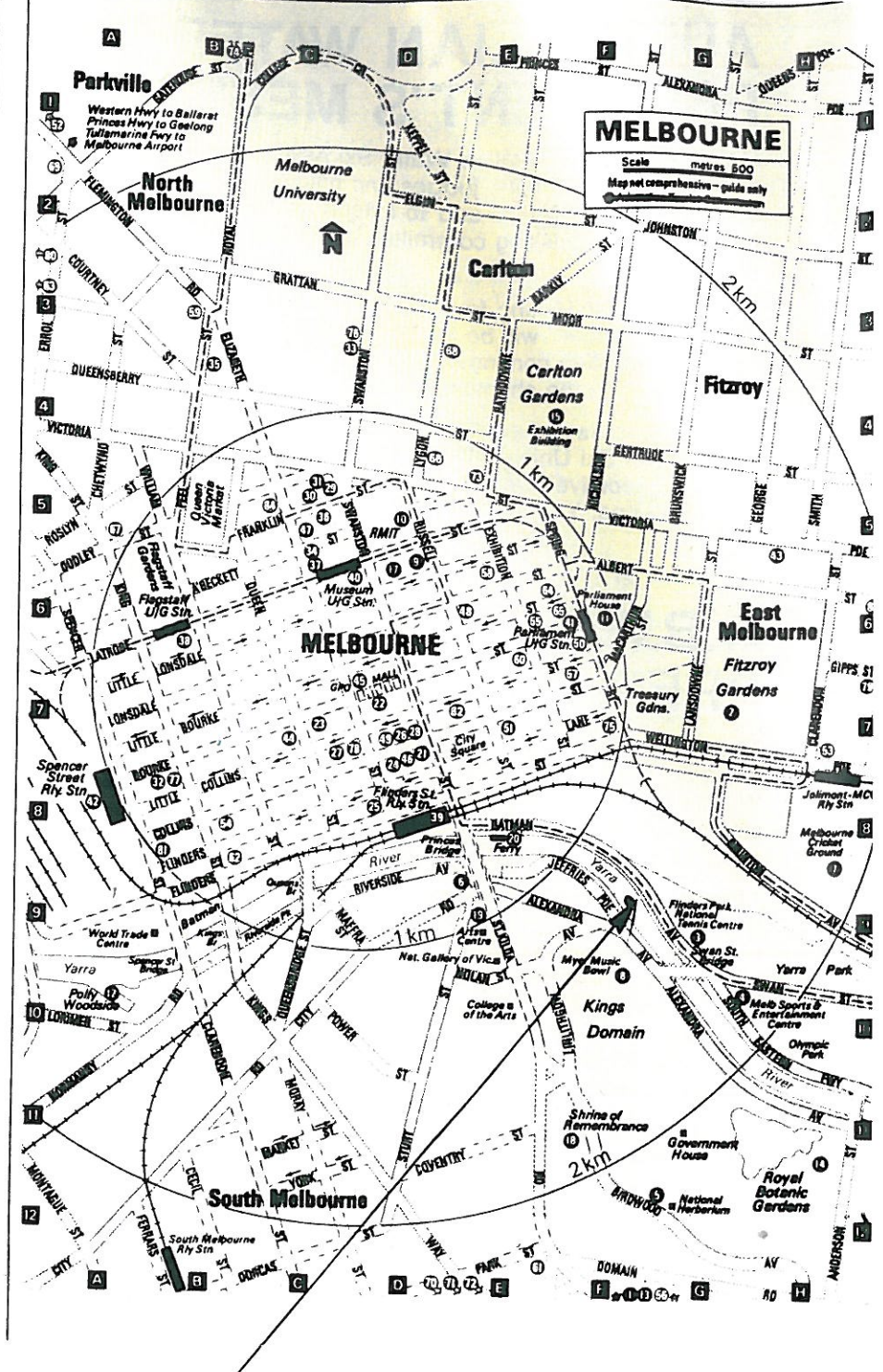

Situated at the head of Port Phillip Bay and mouth of the Yarra River now famous for the unique Moomba Masters Waterski Tournament, the Greater Melbourne Area covering 6,110 square kms nestling at the base of the Dandenong Ranges and accommodating a 2.8 million population.

Melbourne is the mecca for sporting achievements hosting world noted events, such as the Melbourne Cup, Moomba Masters Water Skiing, Australian Open Tennis, International Cricket at the famous Melbourne Cricket Ground home of Australian Rules Football, and now the World Barefoot Water Skiing Championships. So, welcome to Melbourne, join Crocodile Dundee and throw a shrimp on the barby and for one week call Melbourne home.





# THE HISTORY OF BAREFOOT WATERSKIING

## OVER A QUARTER OF A CENTURY OF BAREFOOT WATERSKIING

The first man to meet the challenge of barefoot waterskiing was Dick Pope Jnr., an American, as far back as 1947. The first barefoot competition was held in 1950 at the Cypress Gardens Dixie Championships.

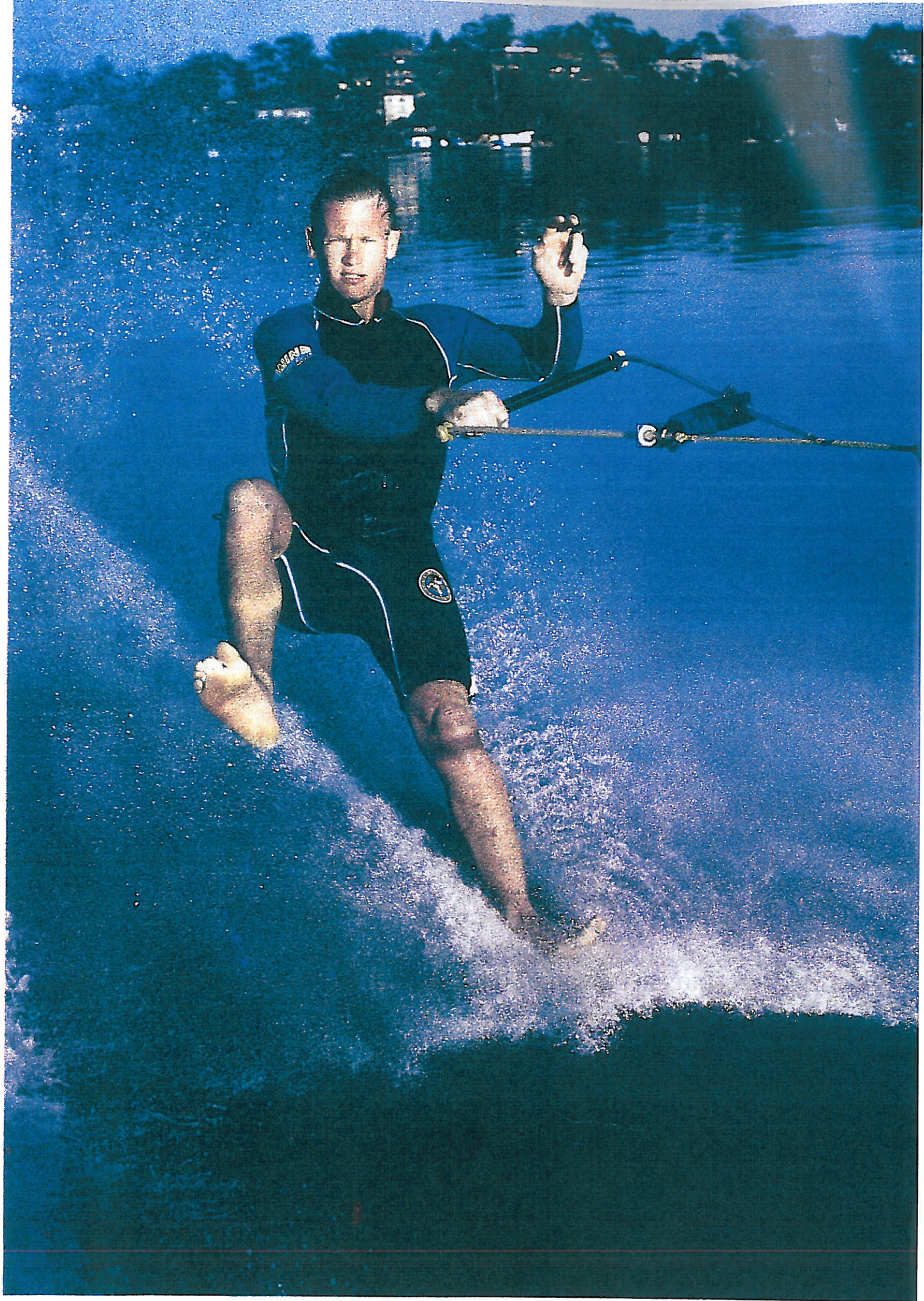
Style and complex eventing as seen today was left to the Australians who have dominated the sport over the last 20 years. In March 1960, at Sackville, the Australian Barefoot Waterski Club was formed by such great exponents as Jack Murray (deceased), Ray Leighton, John Hollands and Ron Marks. In April 1963, Australia held its first official competition patronised by 38 skiers and eventually won by Irwin Luthiger.

The growth of the sport has been spectacular. Such greats as Ken Matthews, Gary Barton, Mary McMillan, Brett Wing and Kim Lampard have all carried Australian Barefooting into the forefront of World competition.

Such tricks as 180, 360 & 720 degree turns have been developed and modern standards astound the champions of only ten years ago. One of the more momentous steps in the development of the sport was the holding of the first World Barefoot Waterski Championships in Canberra in 1978. Fifty-four competitors from 11 nations gathered on the glass-like waters of the Molonglo River and so began an international rivalry that has boosted the barefoot art to an Olympic level. Again in 1985, 15 nationals competed at the Molonglo with Australia again World Champions.

With World and Australian Champions competing at the 6th World Titles, Melbourne will be treated to some of the most spectacular and aggressive skiing in the history of the sport.







# BRETT WING — THE ULTIMATE WARRIOR

The name Wing has become a household name in waterskiing circles. Whether it be in the arena of competitive skiing, judging, administration or the media, the Wing family has high profiled for the last two decades — two decades which have coincided with a dramatic evolution in all disciplines of our beloved sport.

Brett has the unique distinction of never having been defeated for an overall championship at either an Australian or world level in barefooting. People stood aghast as Brett dominated the competitive arena whilst at the same time pioneering many of the tricks performed by our skiers today. Indeed the last twenty-five years of footing owes a great debt to Brett and the dedication and prowess he displayed whilst the sport was indeed a fledgling.

Brett after winning three consecutive World Titles — Canberra 1978, United States 1981 and Acapulco 1983 — turned his efforts to Tournament and Show Skiing where he is regarded as one of the World's best. Very few would deny that if an overall contest were held across the disciplines of waterskiing, namely; trial, barefoot, tournament and show, Brett Wing would be an invincible force.

Brett, the waterskiing fraternity in general, and barefooters specifically, recognise you as the all time great.

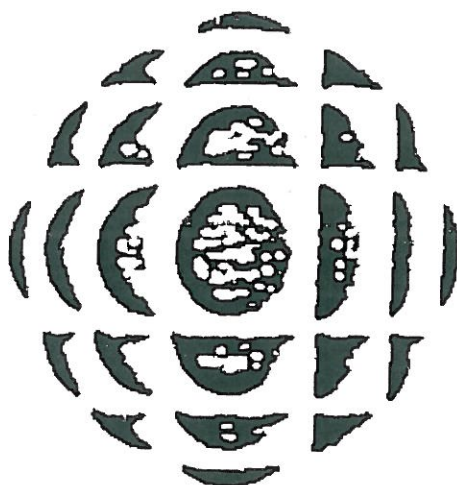

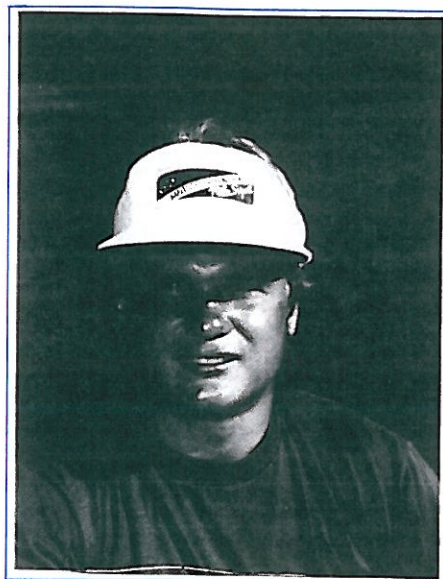

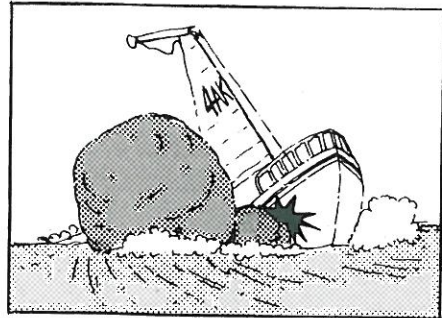

# THE EVENT

## TRICKS —

Each competitor is allowed 2 passes of 15 seconds duration in which time they are to attempt as many tricks as possible. They may ski either forward or backwards and at whatever speed they nominate. At the beginning of the pass the skier may attempt any start method to obtain barefoot position and points are awarded for the degree of difficulty. Typical start methods are:

Forwards Tumbleturn Start  
Forwards Rope on Toe Standup  
Backwards Deepwater Starts.

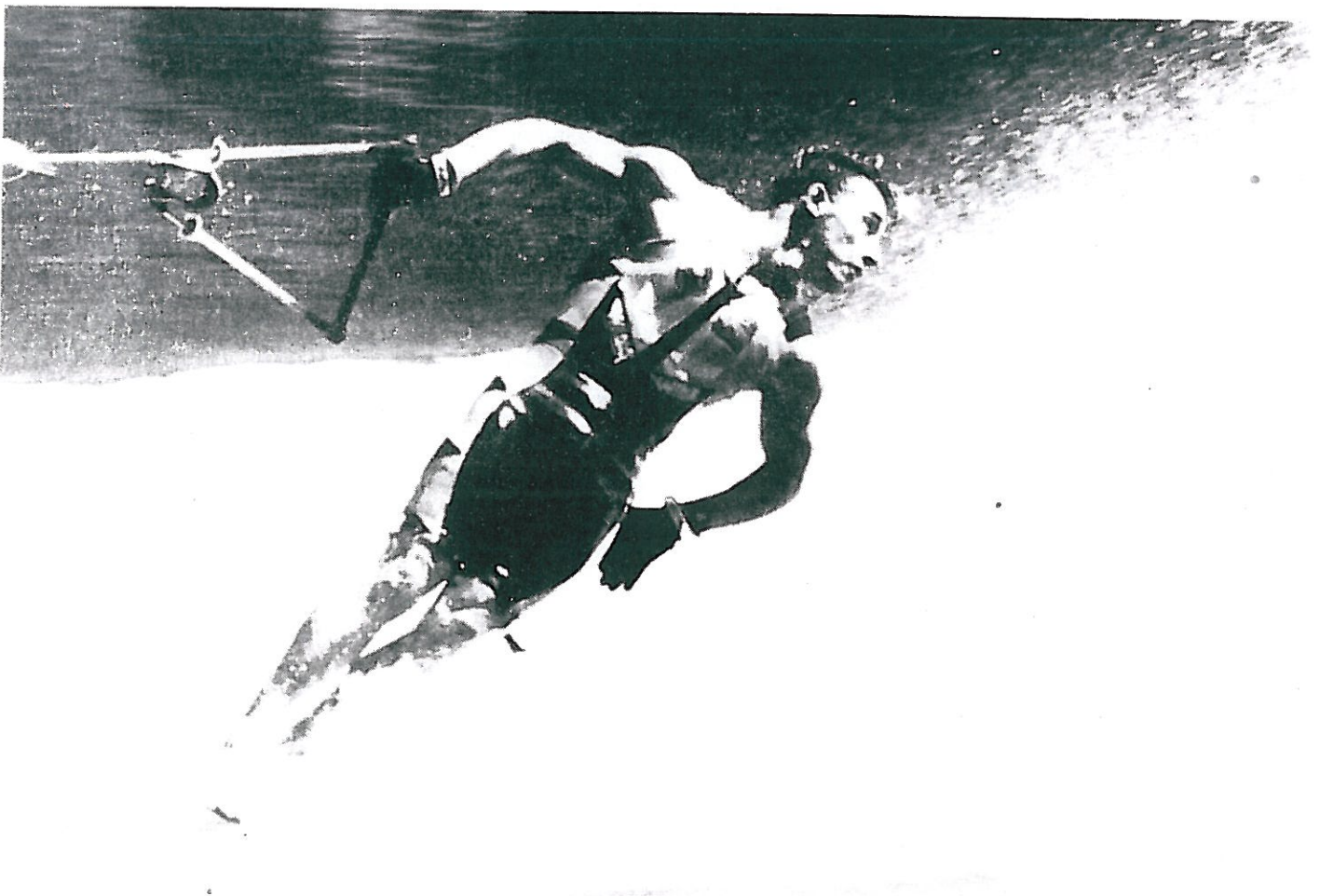
During the 15 second passes, skiers may execute such tricks as:

Rope in Teeth	180° turns
Rope on Neck	360° turns
Rope on Toe	540° turns
Tumbleturns	720° turns
Rope on Toe	180° turns



The Tricks event is regarded as the blue water event of Barefoot Water Skiing. Men's current world record 5240 points held by Dodd Dwyer, Australia and women's 2010 points Debbie Pugh Australia.

## WAKE SLALOM

The object of this event is for the skier to perform as many crosses from one side of the boat wake to the other in 2 passes, each of 15 seconds. Skiers may ski either forward or backwards and on either one or two feet and at whatever speed nominated by the skier. Points are awarded for each cross based on the degree of difficulty. Men's current world record 1545 points held by Don Mixon Jnr. U.S.A. and women's 1190 points, Lori Powell, U.S.A.

## JUMP

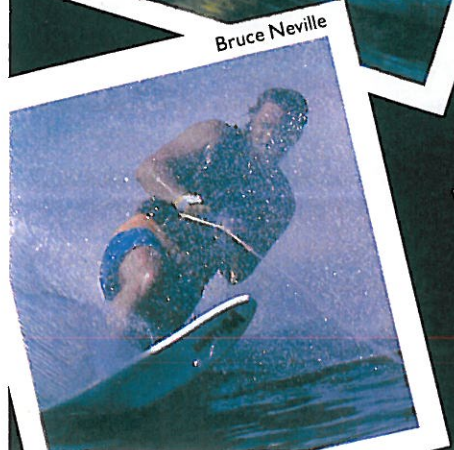
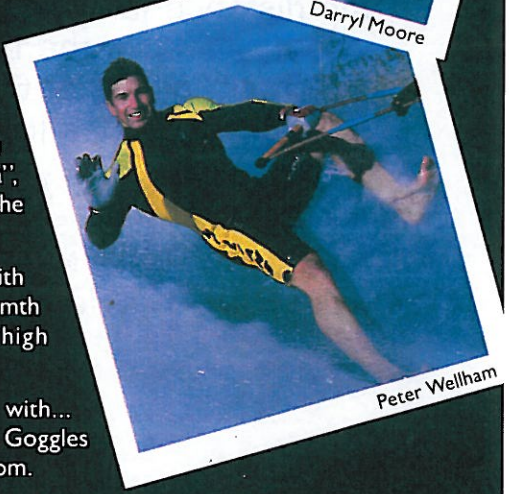
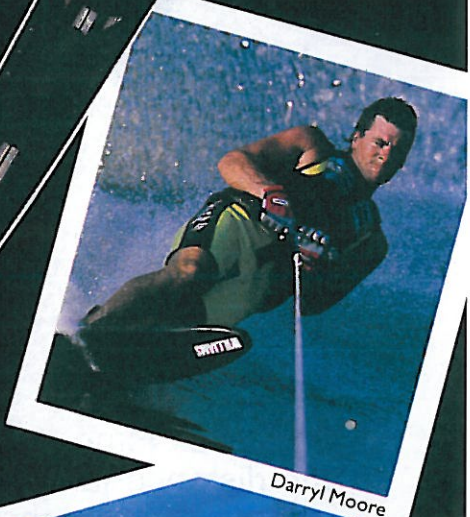
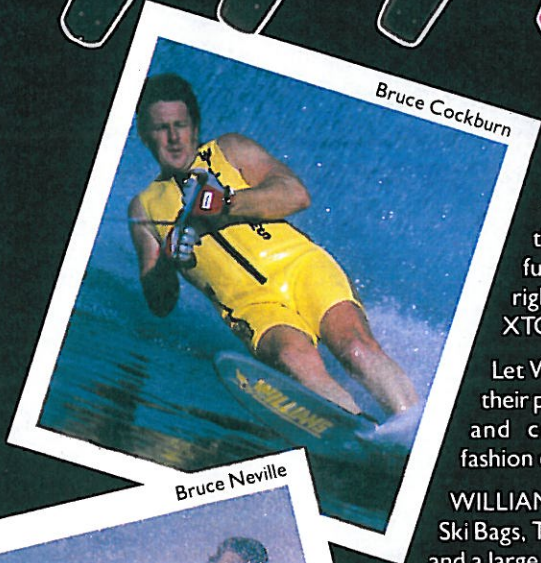
In this event skiers must ski on their bare feet over a floating fibreglass jump (ramp) and ski away to record the jump. The greater the distance jumped the greater number of points are awarded. Each skier nominates the boat speed and distance from the jump, with a maximum speed of 67 kph allowed. Each skier being allowed a maximum of three jumps.

The jump event is considered by most people to be the most exciting event in barefoot skiing. Men's current world record 21.10 metres held by Gavin O'Mahoney, Australia, and Women's 12.40 metres Jacqueline Pfeiffer, Switzerland.
