



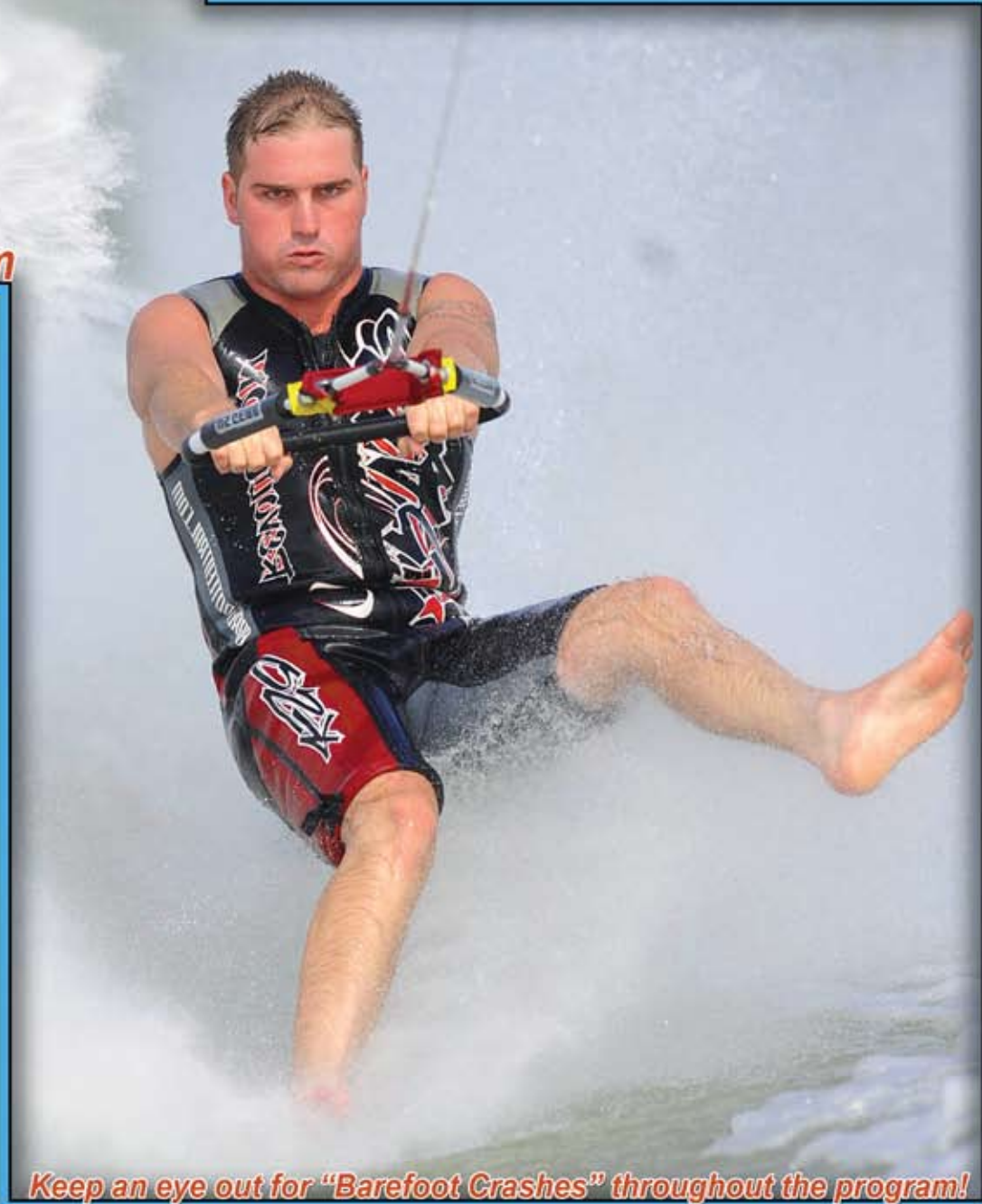

Barefoot Ski Ranch was given its name because it incorporates two passions of Stuart Parsons', barefoot waterskiing and wildlife, with the help of Aaron York. One of the main goals in building the Barefoot Ski Ranch was not only to offer a world-class site for barefoot skiers to enjoy, but to enhance the popularity and presence of barefoot waterskiing itself.

The Barefoot Ski Ranch has hosted a number of tournaments including the South Central Regions regional tournament and most recently the 2010 and 2011 Jump Jam. The Jump Jam showcases the jumps event and offers cash prizes for the participants. The skiers are judged on the longest jump and the skier that broke their personal best score by the most. It is a truly spectacular event that includes world renowned jumpers, food and drinks, and a live band. The Barefoot Ski Ranch has hosted the US National Barefoot Championships in 2011 and 2012.

The USA Team has been a strong presence in the sport of barefoot waterskiing. The enthusiasm for the sport spreads across the US. The South Central Region, home to the Barefoot Ski Ranch, boasts members that are dedicated to making the sport of barefooting the best it can be.

Interactive displays provide the opportunity to match stride, height, hand and shoe size to those of an average NBA player. Answers to a sports trivia quiz can be found throughout the Hall of Fame.
